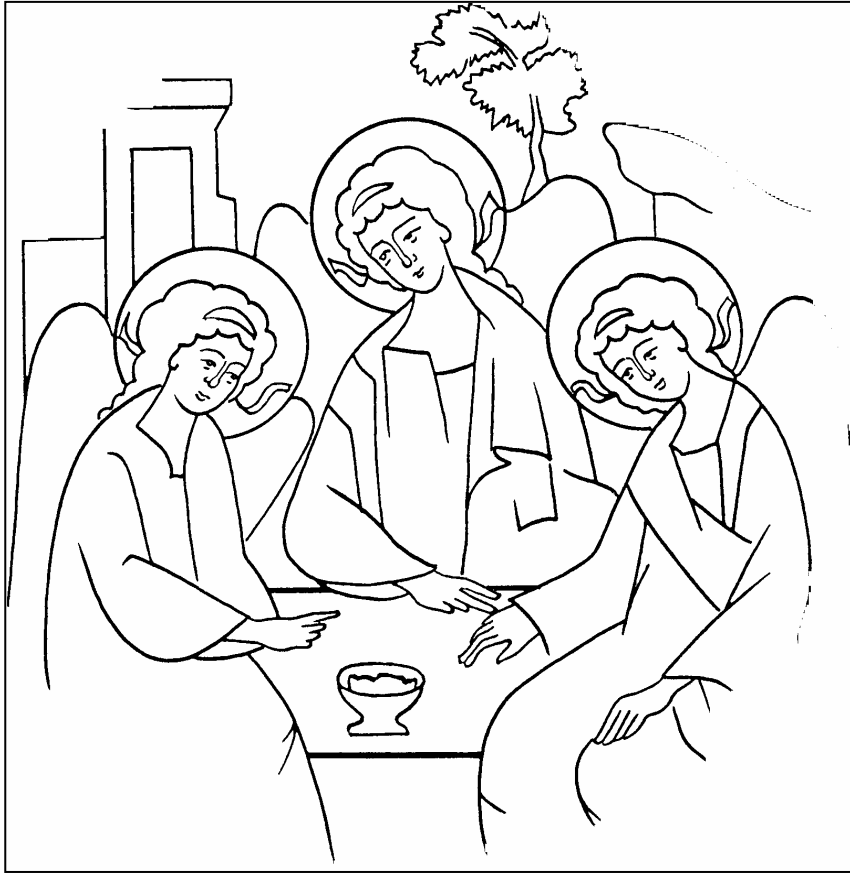
## ***God Loves Me***

*God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.*

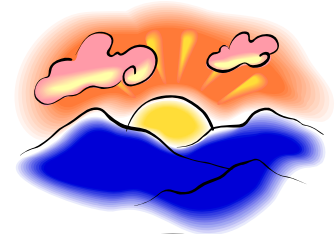


2. Who made you and loves you?

when we go to sleep each night? (9)

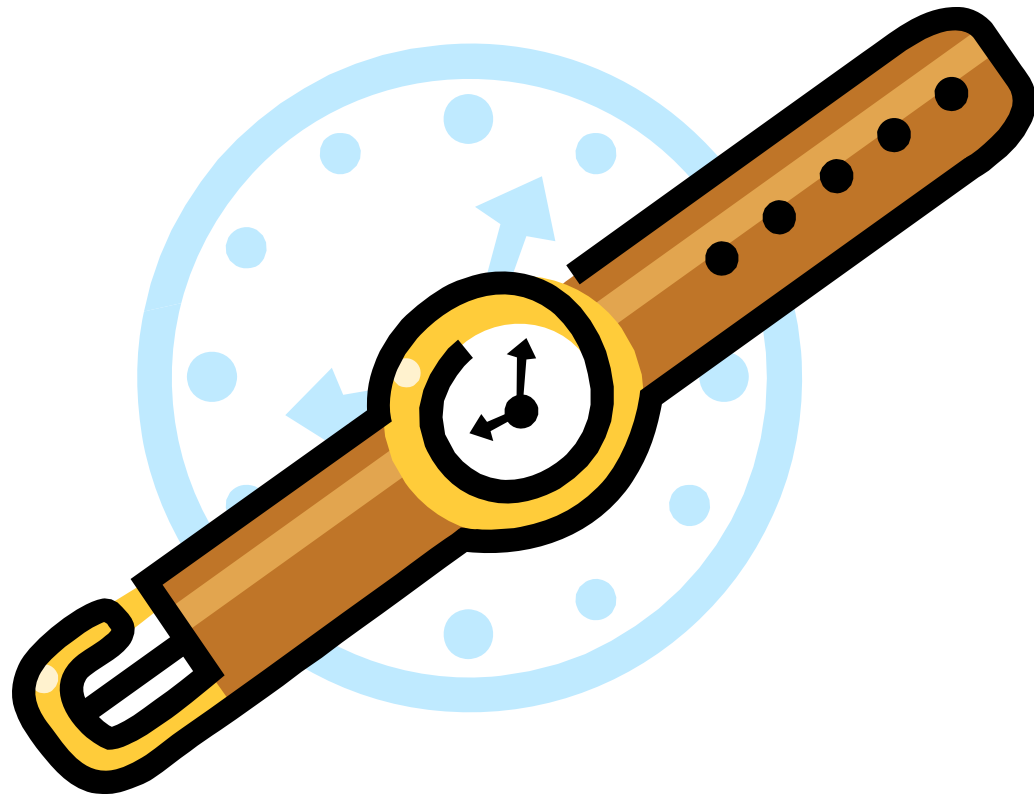

4. How often should we say “thank you” to God? (9)

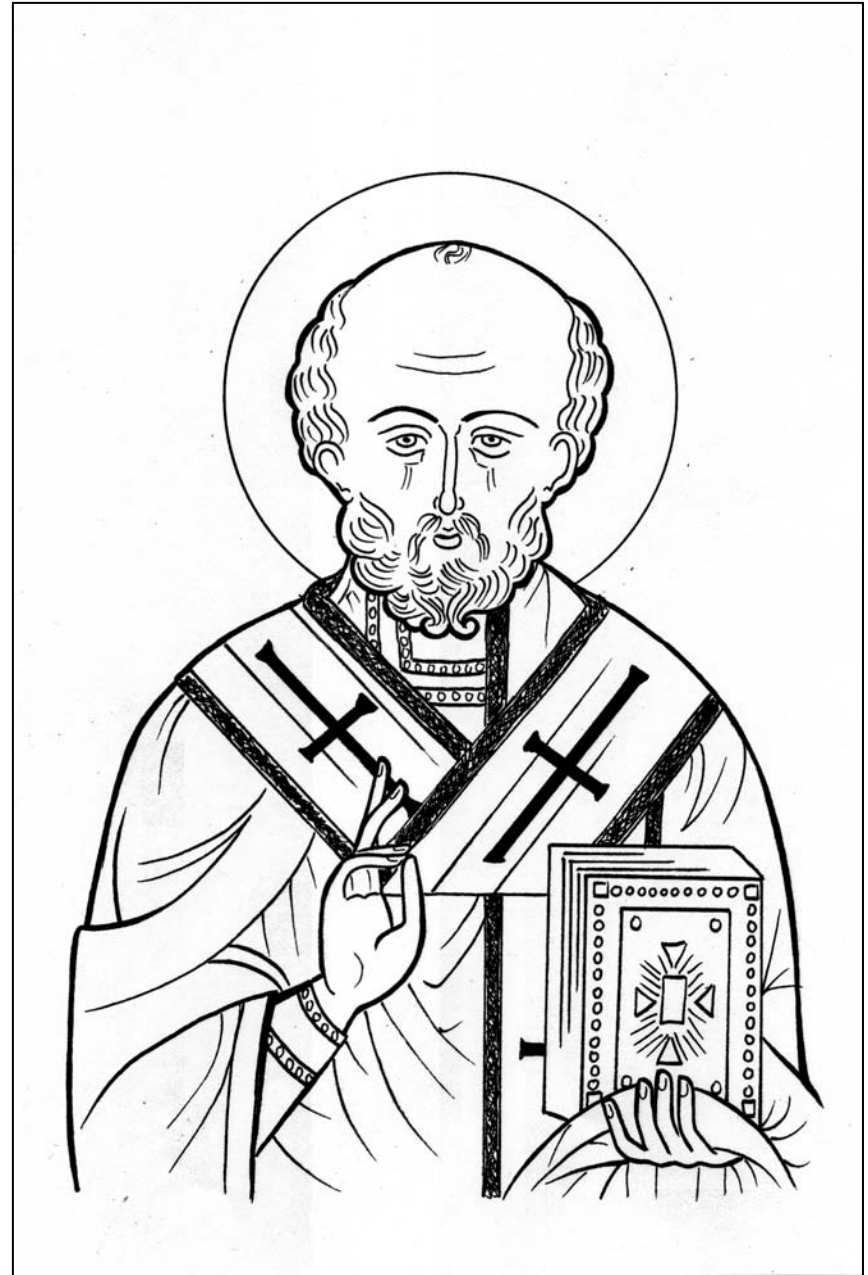
*We should thank God*

kind.*





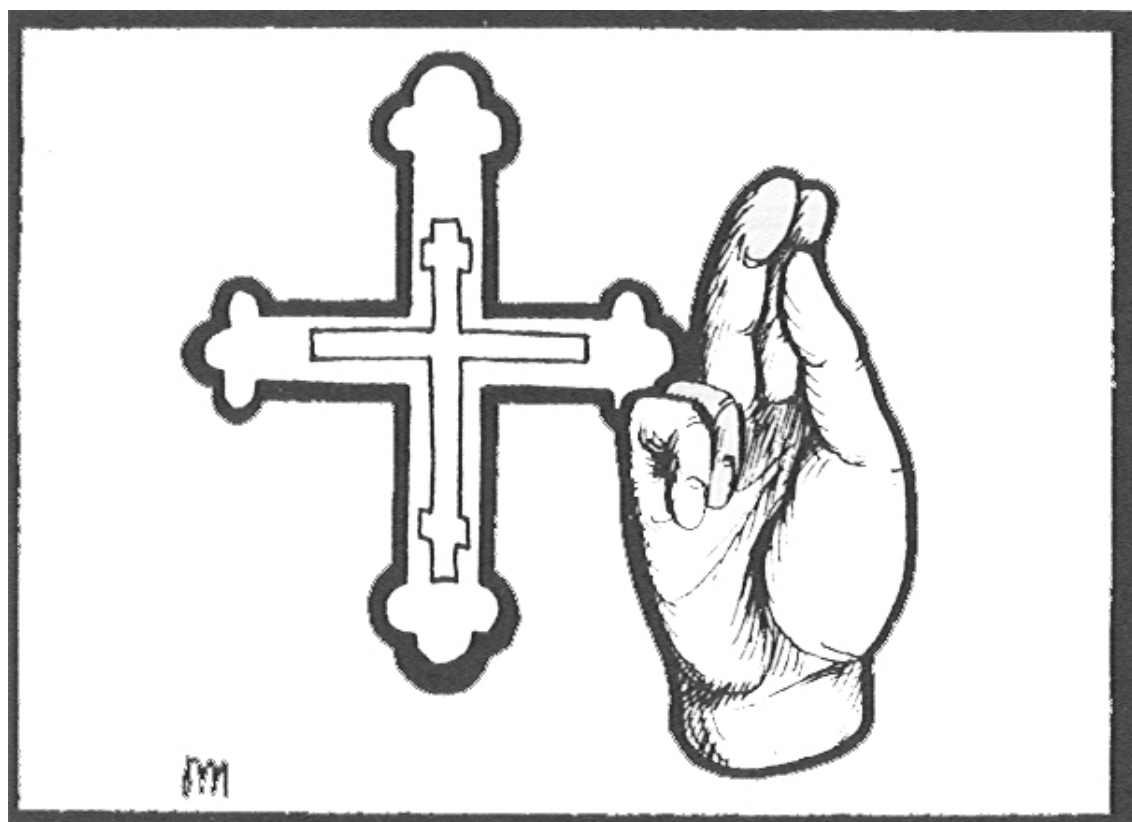
6. What happens at baptism?
