At least two \$2,500.00 Scholarships will be present each year.  
In some years more than two scholarships will be awarded

Fill out all pages of this application and provide all requested materials. **Incomplete applications will not be accepted.**

All materials must be **postmarked by May 15<sup>th</sup>** and received at the above address no later than May 22<sup>nd</sup>; this includes all transcripts and materials requested below.

**Be sure to do the following and they are listed in order of importance:**

## Church and Youth Group Activities

This is an important part of your application. Be sure to provide a complete listing of your activities for the past three years **ONLY** and be sure to have this page signed by your pastor or Youth Director/Advisor of your Parish.

## High School/Civic / Social Activities

Please list **ONLY** the last three years of Activities. Remember to sign and also have your parents sign this page legally stating that you in fact have done all of these activities for the duration you have stated.

## Grades and Test Scores

- Have your High School directly send your official, signed and sealed, transcripts to the Francis Maria Scholarship Committee at the above address.
- If in the first two years of college you must send your College and High School transcripts and SATs and/or ACT Scores.
- If you are attending college and have three full years of grades you do not need to send your High School grades, but you must send your SAT Scores.
  - Transcripts must include all SAT, SAT II, AP and ACT Test results.
  - Canadian Students should send in their equivalent scores, including any AP test Scores

## Short Essay

This essay is your opportunity to tell us about yourself and why we should consider you for this scholarship. Please carefully follow the instructions for this essay found on page 5. Your essay may be as short as 150 words, or as long as 500 words. While this is listed last, **it is very important in the final determination of scholarships** and often is the final determiner of who gets a scholarship.

## Financial Aid:

Fill out all areas of the financial aid section

- USA Students - must attach a signed copy of the *FAFSA Student Aid Report* which shows the *Expected Family Contribution Amount*. The *FAFSA* is a free Federal Application that all US Students applying for financial aid in most colleges will need to fill out each year. You only need to send the page which shows the Family Expected Financial Contribution – be sure that both the student's and at least one parents signs this page.
- Canadian Students need to send a signed copy of their latest parents' and their own Canadian Province & Federal Income Tax Assessment
- You must send to us a copy of your financial aid award letter from your college, for the current year, once you receive it.
- **If the above information is not sent you will receive 0 points for the financial need area.**
