The Antiochian House of Studies Residency for St. Stephen's and Doctor of Ministry students is August 28th through September 9th this year. Doctor of Ministry students will attend both weeks. St. Stephen's students will attend one week, either Week 1 or Week 2. Overseas International students in the St. Stephen's program have the option of attending both weeks in the same year. Check the chart below to determine which week to attend.. Be sure to register for the correct session.

¹ Students in the Youth Ministry, Musicology, or Iconology track must be present for the weekend.

² If you are not enrolled in of one of the specialization tracks, then you are part of the Theology track which is for regular St. Stephen Students.

Students in the Musicology specialization track and Western Rite students attend Week 1. Students in the Youth Ministry and Iconology specialization tracks attend Week 2. Please register for the appropriate week. All Iconology, Musicology and Youth Ministry track students must also be present over the weekend (September 2-4th this year) for additional specialization workshops. Be sure to register for the weekend if you are in one of these specialization tracks. The specialization classes for Iconology and Musicology are restricted to students enrolled in those tracks.

Arrivals and Departures: Doctor of Ministry students and St. Stephen's students in the Musicology and Theology tracks (including Western Rite Theology track students) must arrive at The Heritage and Learning Center on the Sunday before classes begin: Aug. 28th for Week 1 or Sept. 4th for Week 2. Iconology track students must arrive **before noon on Friday, Sept. 2nd**. Youth Ministry track students must arrive Friday evening, Sept. 2nd. If your departure date is Sept. 2nd, you may leave *after* 4:00 PM; if your departure date is September 9th, you may

leave *after* 2:00 PM. Musicology track students may leave Saturday after lunch or may leave Sunday. A social activity is planned Saturday night for students who stay over. Sunday, we attend Divine Liturgy in Johnstown with brunch at the parish.

Please remember that all students in the St. Stephen's Program are required to attend three Residency Sessions, one after each year of course work, in order to graduate.

We look forward to welcoming all our current St. Stephen's and Doctor of Ministry students at the 2010 Antiochian House of Studies Residency.
