- Bachelor's degree
- Ability to teach and model the teachings of the Orthodox Christian faith
- Have a strong passion for connecting young people to Christ and His church
- Experience working in the Church environment
- Youth Work experience

Preferred Qualifications:

- Degree in Theology from an Orthodox Christian Seminary or College

Specific Responsibilities:

- Oversee & develop the current youth ministry programs of the parish:
 - Church School (grades Pre-School through 12) will work closely with the Church School director
 - Vacation Church School (grades Pre-School through 4)
 - Jesus Youth Fan Club (grades 4, 5, and 6)
 - Teen SOYO (grades 7 through 12)
- Maintain regular communication with the youth and their families through the Sunday Bulletin, Monthly Messenger, email, parish Web Site and St. George Face Book page as well as personal communication
- Update youth sections of parish web site with articles, announcements and photos
- Recruit, train, and supervise advisors & leaders for each of our ministry groups.
- Assist with planning of regular activities for each age group, including meetings, outings, retreats, service projects, and field trips.
- Encourage participation in Diocese and Archdiocese programs including Diocese SOYO Retreat, Bible Bowl, Oratorical Festival, Antiochian Village, etc.
